2011-2012 Fundraisers

The following list is as of January 24th, 2012. Some dates are unknown due to other events at G-CHS and Lucas Oil.

General account fundraisers are those whose profits go directly to the general fund. The general fund is used to pay for items such as instruction, music, equipment, props, supplies, contest entrance fees etc. The general fund is made up of student fees, sponsorships, donations and many fundraisers such as restaurant nights, cheese and sausage sales and car washes just to name a few.

Student account fundraisers are those fundraisers in which participating students receive a designated amount of money to be applied toward their band account. These fundraisers would include cookie dough sales and working at Lucas Oil, the Speedway or the State Fair. Any family member or friend is welcome to work a student fundraiser on your student's behalf. Please ensure whomever, is running the fundraiser, has the names of all people working for your student's account to ensure proper crediting of income.

Unfortunately not all fundraiser's we do throughout the year can be student account fundraisers. Without having fundraiser's that benefit the general fund we would see a significant increase in band fees to make up for the loss of income to our projected budget. Please help with both types of fundraisers.

February 2012:

Lucas Oil – student account – Super Bowl Sunday - work the concessions at the Game and earn a minimum of \$50 towards a student's account of your choice. NFL game dates and times are subject to change.

Indoor Percussion Ensemble Home Contest - general account – February 25th – We will need people all day to work the contest. Proceeds benefit the entire band program.

Spring Fundraiser – student account – Coffee, Tea and Hot Chocolate. Details and dates are being finalized.

April 2012:

Music Marathon – general account – April 7th – students collect donations for an all day “music marathon”. The day ends with a silent auction and an evening performance in the gym.

May 2012:

Indy 500 Parking – student account – TBA - Earn \$7.00 per hour, for a student’s account, working the parking lot at the speedway. Minimum age is 16 years-old and is open to anyone that wants to work for a student’s account. Contact Steve Owen (owen_steve@att.net) to sign-up or with questions.

Jazz Steak Dinner – general account – TBA – Help setup, serve, cook or tear down or just enjoy a steak dinner while listening to our jazz band.

June 2012:

Indianapolis Air show – general account – June 22-24 – work a five hour shift and receive lunch, free parking, a t-shirt and free admission to the show. The band boosters receive a donation from the air show.
